Organic certification



What is it?

- Since 2001, the state organic seal has been in place to label organic products more uniformly (BMEL, 2022)
- All products that have been produced and controlled in accordance with EU legislation on organic farming can bear the organic logo. The basis for this is the "Organic Labeling Act" (BMEL, 2022)

Why opt for it?

- Social & environmental: Your contribution to sustainable & organic food production
- Awareness & trust: Many customers associate organic certified products with high product quality and transparency.
- Point of sale: Prerequisite for the sale of your products in organic (super) markets

Application & Costs

- Application via eco-control bodies. <u>Here</u> you will find all companies at a glance
- It pays to get quotes: prices for certification differ depending on the certification company
- One-time costs: Costs for your initial certification
- Annual cost: Cost of annual certification to maintain organic certification
- If applicable, additional costs for the certification of your partner companies (e.g. contract manufacturers, warehousing & logistics, etc.)

Labeling of the products



- The EU organic logo & organic seal may only be used if the legal requirements are met & certification is maintained through regular controls
- All ingredients of agricultural origin must come from organic agriculture
- There are official requirements for the use of the EU organic logo (size, color, position)
- There are two different logos: if you want to use the organic logo after certification, the product MUST carry the European logo (fig. right). The German logo (Fig. left) may be displayed additionally on a voluntary basis.
- A complete organic certification of your product consists of (BMEL, 2022):
 - EU organic logo (+ state organic seal, if applicable)
 - Code number of the responsible organic inspection body
 - Labelling of ingredients originating from organic farming incl. indication of the origin of the ingredients (e.g. EU farming, non-EU farming, EU/non-EU farming)

What documents?

- When applying, a distinction is made between the following categories:
 - Production & Processing
 - Trade
 - Importers
 - Out-of-home catering companies
- Checklists for the requirements to apply for the organic label & the EU organic logo can be seen here
